Emergency Apparatus Mechanic/Technician

Bonnie Vale Inc dba Twin Tier Fire & Safety Services is currently seeking an **experienced** Mechanic to serve as an Emergency Apparatus Road Mechanic/Technician.

Definition:

Under general supervision, the Emergency Apparatus Mechanic/Technician is responsible for diagnosing and performing repairs on various diesel and gasoline powered vehicles and equipment as well as fire pumps, small engines, and related components, including but not limited to fire apparatus, ambulances, and school buses. Mechanics/Technicians work and receive on-the-job training in the maintenance and repair shop, which includes inspecting, maintaining, and repairing fire/emergency apparatus and related equipment and school buses. Individuals in this position perform assigned maintenance and repair and possess the ability to work independently with minimal supervision.

Minimum Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Provide proof of eligibility to work in the United States.
- Possess and maintain a valid Driver's License; with a minimum a PA Class B Commercial Driver's License or similar Commercial Drivers License. School bus and passenger endorsements and other future endorsements may be required.
- Obtain and maintain Emergency Vehicle Technician certification within two (2) years of employment.
- Obtain and maintain PA State Vehicle inspection certification within two (2) years of employment.
- Upon hire, must have personal hand tools suitable for the performance of duties.
- Maintain physical ability and stamina to perform the tasks, responsibilities and the essential functions of the position. Reasonable accommodation can be made to enable people with disabilities to perform the described essential functions of the position.
- Possess reliable transportation.
- Ability to travel.

NOTE: The education or experience requirements may be modified or waived at the sole discretion of the Employer. At least one of the education or experience requirements must be met; both requirements cannot be modified or waived. An equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job is required.

Education:

Possession of a High School Diploma, or General Equivalency Diploma (GED)
Completion of a heavy-duty, diesel, or industrial program from a vocational/technical.
At least 5 years of heavy truck or emergency vehicle repair experience especially on-road/on-site work.



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Experience:

- Experience with diagnosis and repair of complex electrical and computerized motors, transmissions, and other vehicle components.
- Possess or ability to obtain Emergency Vehicle Technician certification
- Possess or ability to obtain Air Conditioning training.
- Possess DOT physical.
- Be dependable, helpful, respectful, honest, hardworking, professional, and a team player.
- Self-motivated and driven to learn by trying and doing on their own rather than waiting for direction.
- Willing to learn new technology, equipment, and apparatus types.

Bonus Experience (Preferred)

- Previous experience with fire apparatus in a repair, testing, pumping or operating capacity and/or volunteer firefighting experience.

Typical Duties:

- Performs a variety of diagnostic, servicing, maintenance, and repair work involving all mechanical components, parts, and accessories, including any overhaul and rebuilding of miscellaneous components, tire mounting, repair, rewiring and installation of specialized equipment. Work takes place in our shop or at the customer's location.
- Performs annual PA state inspections on emergency apparatus and school buses, which will include driving the vehicles, checking the transmission, engine, and general components to ensure everything is in proper working condition and conforms to all safety and inspection requirements.
- Conducts scheduled inspections of emergency apparatus, and equipment in fire stations to ensure everything is in compliance with all safety standards. If equipment is not in compliance, documents situation, reports situation to Supervisor, and completes repair of the equipment when authorized.
- Uses a variety of diagnostic equipment to determine sources of problems and to ensure proper adjustment and operation of emergency apparatus or school bus systems.
- Operates welding and fabrication equipment in making minor repairs and fabricating parts.
- Performs road tests and checking emergency apparatus or school buses for proper operation and for detecting the source of the problems.
- Attends training sessions and conferences to keep current with standard maintenance and repair practices.
- Travels to customer location to complete scheduled maintenance and repairs.



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- May respond to emergency road service calls by assessing, repairing, the fire apparatus and/or other vehicles as assigned by the Supervisor.
- Maintains personal work station and/or service truck.
- Maintains and repairs shop equipment and cleans shop area.
- Completes service orders using online program.
- Performs other work as needed or directed.

- Operate applicable tools and equipment of the trade;
- Work independently and understand and carryout verbal and written instructions;
- Understand the basic operation of a computer and other electronic equipment;
- Complete basic record keeping;
- Differentiate colors



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- Pay attention to the details of work content, work steps, and final work products.
- Maintaining emotional stability and self-control under pressure, challenge, or adversity.
- Display honesty, adherence to principles, and personal accountability.
- Attend to the needs and expectations of customers in a respectful manner.
- Effectively communicate, maintain interpersonal skills as applied to interaction with coworkers, supervisor, the general public, etc. sufficient to exchange or convey information and to receive work direction.

- Comprehend how mechanical, electrical, and structural systems operate and interact.
- Meet work deadlines and customer expectations.
- Show vigilance and care in identifying and addressing health risks and safety hazards.
- Complete other tasks as assigned.

Work Environment:

Unforeseen Overtime and Unusual Hours:

Due to the emergency nature of the emergency service field, occasionally employees of the Bonnie Vale Inc are required to work extended hours, be called in for overtime hours or have adjustments in their regular schedule to return emergency vehicles to proper operational status.

Travel:

Position will include travel to customer locations during the work day and occasional overnight travel.

Environmental Conditions:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently exposed to fumes or airborne particles, moving mechanical parts and vibration. The employee is occasionally exposed to a variety of extreme conditions. The noise level in the work environment can be loud.
